Travel Arrangements

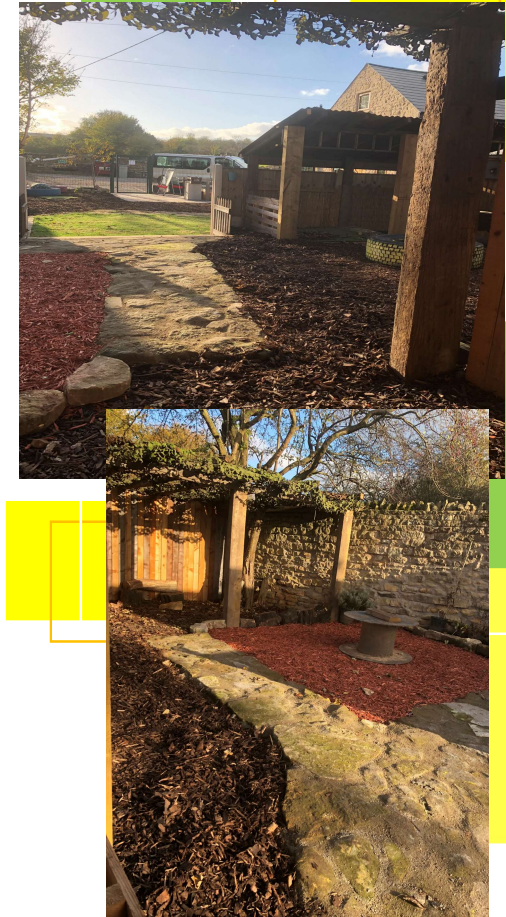
Sunnydale Nursery is situated in Mansfield Woodhouse, behind Northfield Primary School at the top of Cox's Lane.
